World Bid Declaration

ACP is proud to award 15 Bids (5 Paid Bids and 10 At-Large) to **The Cheerleading Worlds** at the 2018 Midwest All Star National Championship.

5 PAID BIDS

ACP will reserve **1** Paid Bid to a Senior Coed Team and will reserve **1** Paid Bid to a Senior All Girl Team. Once the first 2 Paid Bids have been secured, the remaining **3** Full Paid Bids will be awarded to the highest scoring Senior/Senior Coed Teams combined. In the event that any of these teams have a previously earned PAID bid from another event producer, ACP will award the bid(s) to the next highest scoring team(s). ACP reserves the right to award an originally designated Senior/Senior Coed Paid Bid to an International Open/Open Coed Team.

9 SENIOR AT-LARGE BIDS

Once the PAID bids have been secured, ACP will award 7 AT-LARGE Bids to the next 7-overall highest scores within all Senior/Senior Coed Level 5 Divisions teams combined. In the event that any of these 7 teams have a previously earned AT-LARGE Bid from another event producer, ACP will move the AT-LARGE Bid to the next overall Highest Scoring Senior/Senior Coed Level 5 Team(s). ACP reserves the right to award an originally designated Senior/Senior Coed At-Large Bid to an International Open/Open Coed Team.

1 INTERNATIONAL AT-LARGE BID

Will be awarded to the highest scoring International Open/Open Coed Team combined. In the event that a qualifying team has previously earned an International At-Large Bid from another event producer, American Cheer Power will move the International At-Large Bid to the next overall Highest Scoring International Team(s). American Cheer Power reserves the right to award an originally designated International At-Large Bid to a Senior/Senior Coed Team.

In order to be eligible for a World Bid, programs must submit their event rosters. World Team members MUST have a verified USASF Event Roster(s) & the Roster must match registered/competing number of athletes on team.
